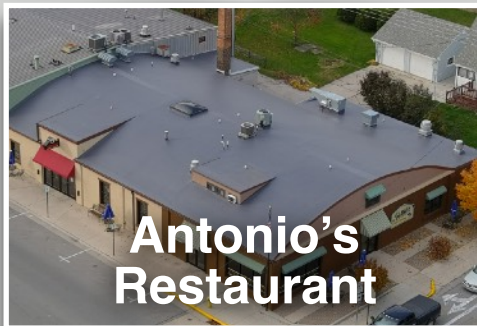

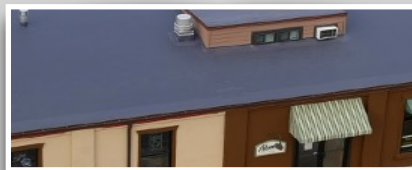
**Sheboygan  
YMCA**

The expansive nature of this fitness facility, including varying levels of rooflines as portions of the building were added over time means a reroof schedule is important both from a budget and lifespan approach. The curved area in the background was the Lifestyle Center, an addition in 2013. The large area to the right is their main gym; reroofed this summer.



**Antonio's  
Restaurant**

The unique rounded shape of this roof provided interesting challenges including the custom curved metal edge on the building's front which resulted in an aesthetically pleasing first-view for approaching customers. An example of what we may encounter during a reroof project: the fascia boards had to be extended and covered with sheet metal. As with all restaurants, there are lots of protrusions requiring hot air sealing of the membrane. A gray membrane vs. the more traditional white was chosen.



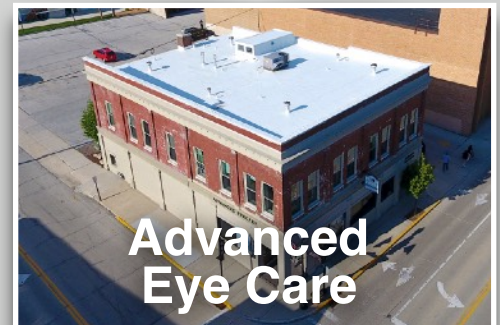
**Kingsbury

This residential project was completed over the course of a year during construction. Three buildings feature 33 total luxury town home-style, two bedroom apartments. Notice the varying height levels of each roof section and the abundance of pipes. Our crew really enjoyed the scenic riverfront setting during the project.
